The annual Great Lakes Waterways Conference – an event involving all segments of the maritime community and addressing the Great Lakes maritime industry's most pressing challenges and future opportunities – will be held Tuesday and Wednesday, February 6-7, 2018 at the Renaissance Cleveland Hotel in downtown Cleveland. Industry Newsbriefs -

- Lake Carriers' Association reports that US-flag Great Lakes vessels moved 85.7 millions tons of cargo in 2017, an increase of 3 percent over 2016. However, the 2017 total was still 2.4 percent below the fleet's long-term average. Iron ore cargoes carried totaled 46 million tons, an increase of 4.3 percent from 2016. Coal loadings increased 2.8 percent to 13.3 million tons, and limestone cargoes increased 1.7 percent to 21.55 million tons. Statistics are available at www.lcaships.com.
- The 2017 St. Lawrence Seaway navigation season (concluded on January 11, 2018) saw Seaway tonnage rising by nearly 9 percent to over 38 million tonnes of cargo. The iron ore, dry bulk, and general cargo categories saw the largest increases. Vessel transits of the System increased by more than 9 percent, totaling 4119 in 2017, up from 3774 in the 2016 season.
- On January 10, 2018, Lake Carriers' Association reported that in 2017, the Great Lakes iron ore trade enjoyed its best year since 2012. Shipments of iron ore on the Lakes totaled 60.3 million tons in 2017, an increase of 10.9 percent over 2016, and the most since 2017. That ore total was also 4.6 percent above the trade's five-year average. Details are available at <u>www.lcaships.com</u>.
- The US Army Corps of Engineers released its extended water levels forecast for January through June for the Great Lakes. The Lakes are expected to rise again this spring for the fifth straight year, with all five lakes expected to have above-average levels. In fact, forecasters estimate that Lake Superior will break a record high level set in the mid-1980s.
- On January 25, 2018, the US Coast Guard National Maritime Center posted a notice about Approval to Test Letters and the transition from previous to current mariner credentialing regulations which went into effect on March 24, 2014. - On January 18, 2018, the US Coast Guard posted a Federal Register Notice proposing new base pilotage rates and surcharges for the 2018 shipping season, in accordance with the Great Lakes Pilotage Act of 1960. Additionally, the Coast Guard is proposing several changes to the Great Lakes pilotage ratemaking methodology. - On January 19, 2018, the USCG announced it had set the random drug testing rate for crewmembers of inspected and uninspected vessels. The 2018 minimum random drug testing rate is set at 25 percent of covered crewmembers and is effective January 1 through December 31, 2018. - On January 16, 2018, the USCG released a Marine Safety Advisory concerning the expansion of DOT drug screening to include semi-synthetic opiates. - On January 8, 2018, the USCG National Maritime Center posted an alert to its website with information for customers sending attachments to NMC through e-mail. It is important to be aware of file size, as large files will not be accepted. - The final iron ore shipments from Escanaba, MI, happened on April 18, 2017, due to closure of the exhausted Empire Mine in Palmer, MI.
- The Port of Green Bay, WI, reported 166 ship visits in 2017. Overall port tonnage totaled 1.833 million metric tons, a one percent increase over 2016.
- In 2017, the Port of Hamilton, ON, handled its highest-ever total of agricultural products. Agricultural cargoes now make up 23 percent of the port's total; that's up from 12.5 percent in 2010. Overall, the port's tonnage for all cargoes was 6 percent higher than in 2016, at 9.86 million metric tonnes for 2017.
