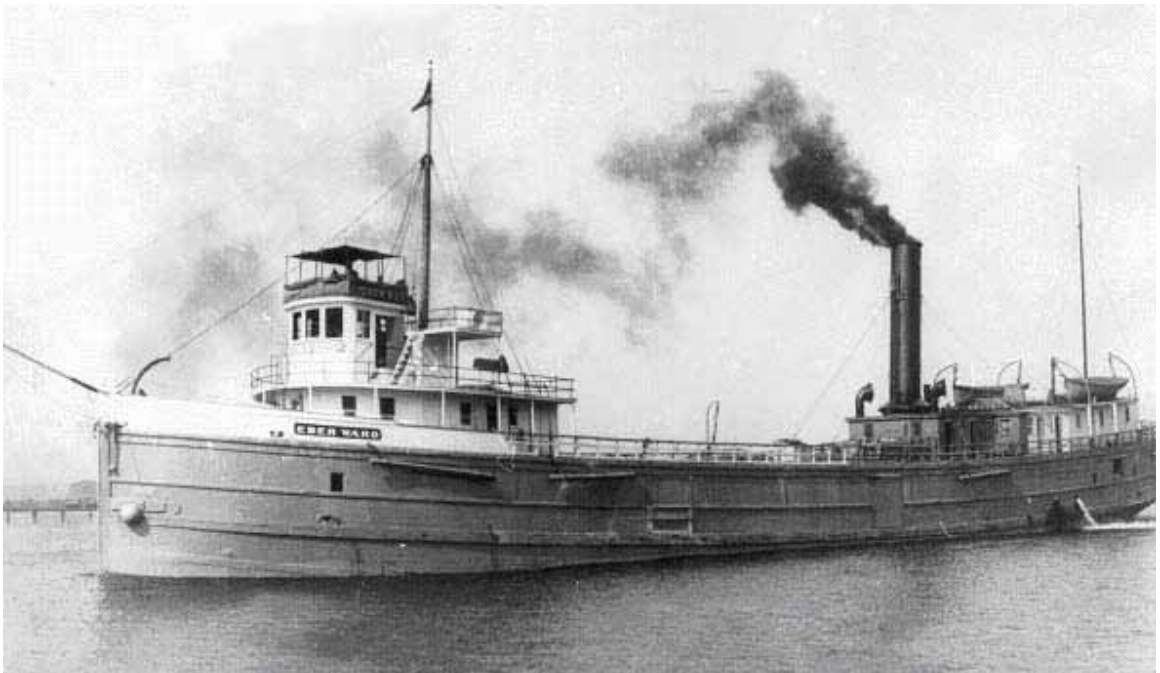


SURVIVING CREW OF THE WARD FROM LEFT TO RIGHT:

The steamer *Eber Ward* sank on April 20, 1909 after encountering heavy ice in the Straits of Mackinac. Of the 16 people on board, 5 perished, and the remaining 11 people were rescued by the steamer *Bennington*. The *Eber Ward* rests 5 miles West of the Mackinac Bridge.
