On August 14th, the crew of the Algoway spotted and reported a pleasure craft and its occupants in distress in waters off Lorain Ohio.

The situation was reported to the USCG and the crew of the Algoway commenced rescue and recovery procedures by launching the workboat with three crew (1st and 3rd mates along with one of their most experienced boat operators) along with their trauma kit, defibrillator and oxygen kit.

The Algoway was maneuvered to windward of the stricken craft to provide a lee for the occupants of the boat and the crew assisting. With the USCG on scene the occupants of the pleasure craft were rescued and the body of a fifth member recovered from the water.

The entire crew of the Algoway are commended for their quick thinking and skilled response in dealing with this unfortunate situation and their actions were instrumental in the rescue of four lives.
