

CAPT. WILLIAM MORTON

—A Great Lakes sailor and ship captain for more than 30 years, Capt. Morton, 73, of 20429 Gaylord, died Monday in Hotel Dieu, Windsor.

A native of Ireland, he came to Detroit in 1914 and sailed for the Great Lakes Steamship Co. prior to his retirement 12 years ago.

Capt. Morton was secretary and treasurer of Detroit Lodge No. 7 of the International Shipmasters' Association, whose officers will be pallbearers. He was also a member of Ionic Lodge No. 474, F.&A.M.
